





# Research Workshop


# What to Expect

All research workshop sessions consist of three(3) phases:

**Data feedback:** From February to June '24, data was gathered through surveys and completed by leaders and members of churches and organisations across south and east Africa. Key elements related to the region and in relation to other regions are shared.

**Data engagement:** Discussions are facilitated with attendees to better understand the data gathered and how it is applied within a ministry, community, and personal capacity. (Small group discussions facilitated by travel support group members)

**Data contextualisation (story telling):** Stories are shared and captured that provide context to the data gathered and discussions had during the data engagement session. *(Story telling captured by video and report writing by travel support group members)*
