

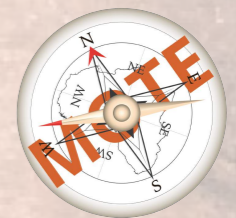

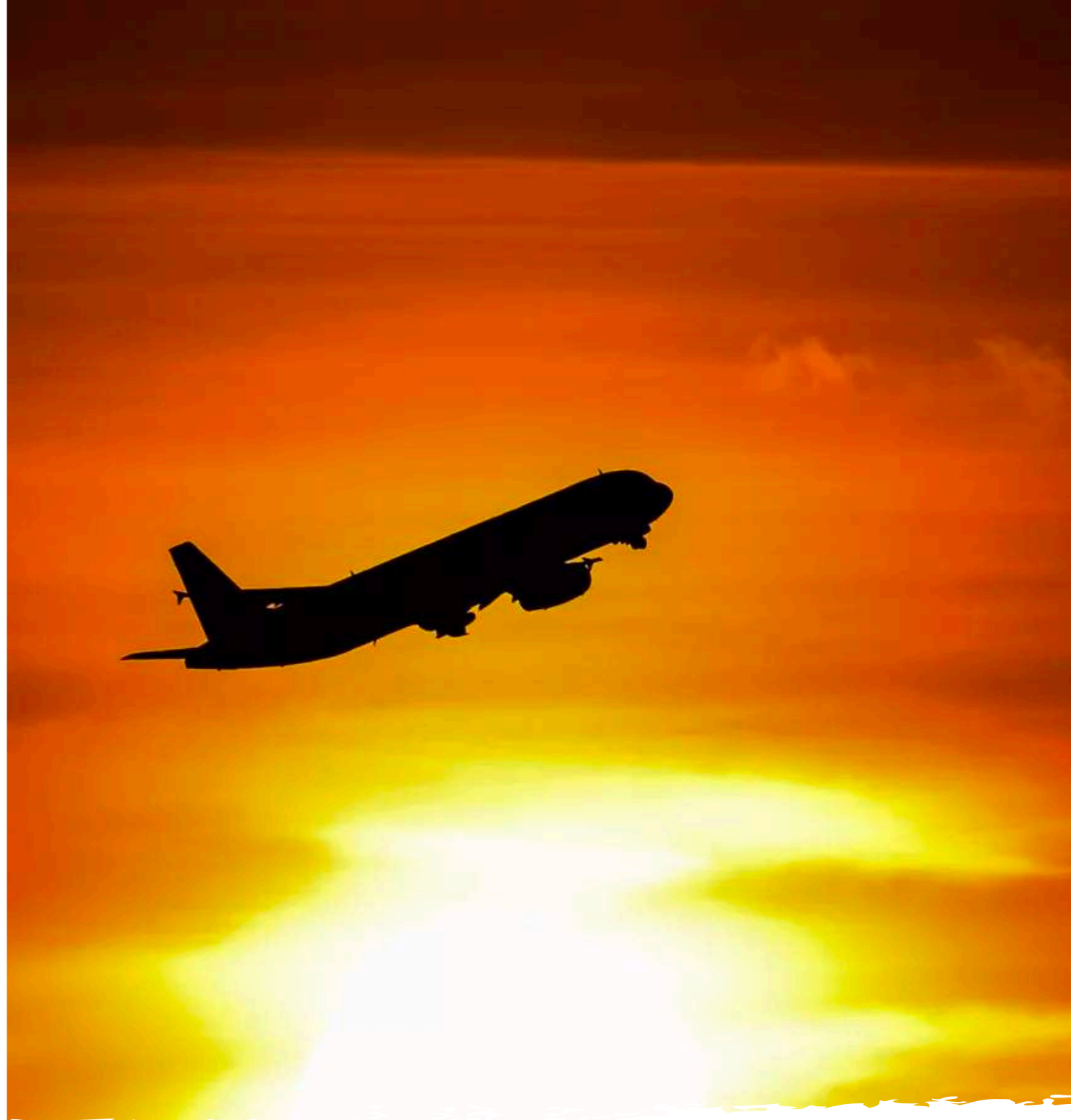

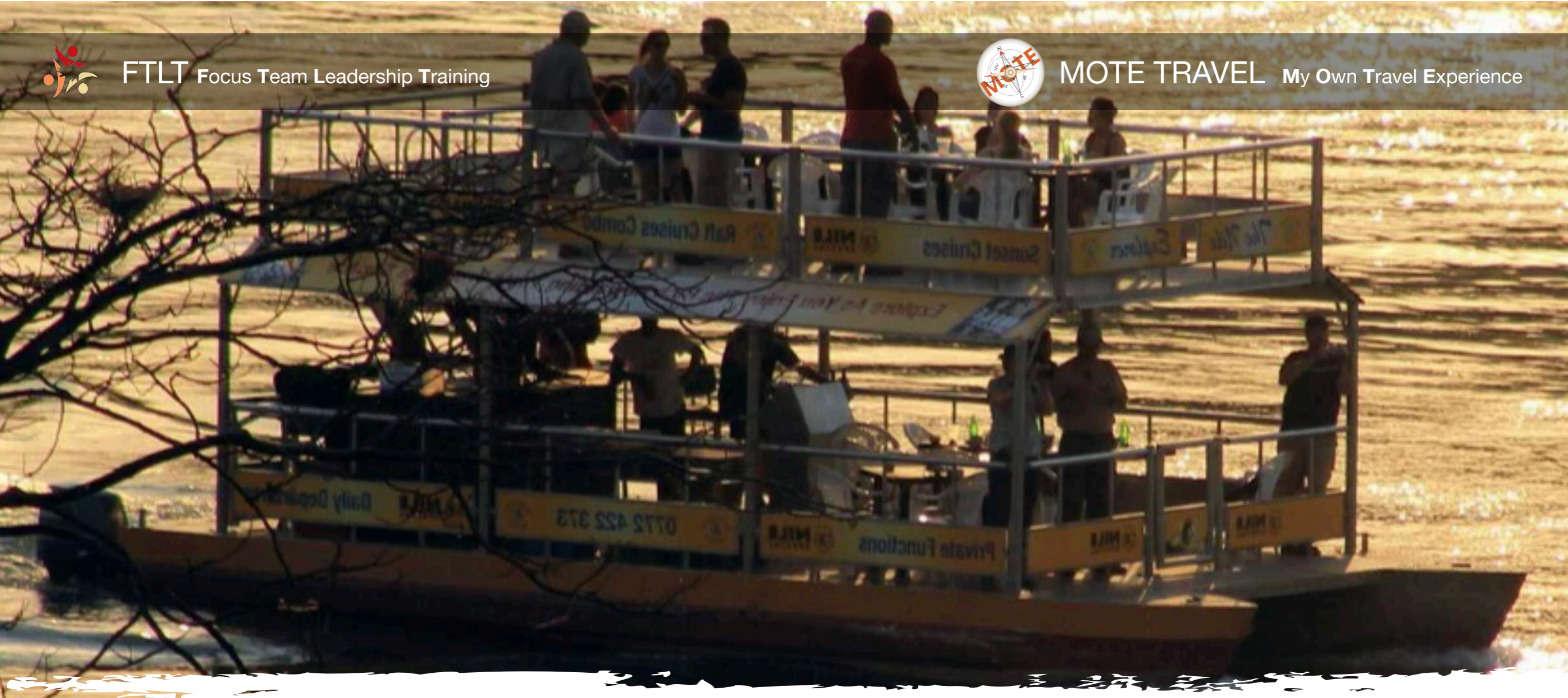

## DAY 1, 2

Upon arrival in Entebbe, you will be met at the airport and make your way to Jinja by shuttle (4 - 5 hours) where you will meet the team. Opportunity will be given to settle in, listen to some experiences lived, and be briefed on the days ahead.

Day 2 is to learn more about the research process, as well as exploring some key sights in the area. The evening includes a sunset boat cruise on the Nile river.

### Key Information

The option does exist for you to upgrade from a sharing safari tent to a private room (based on availability).

## DAY 3, 4

## Research Workshop

## What to Expect

All research workshop sessions consist of three(3) phases:

**Data feedback:** From February to June '24, data was gathered through surveys and completed by leaders and members of churches and organisations across south and east Africa. Key elements related to the region and in relation to other regions are shared.

**Data engagement:** Discussions are facilitated with attendees to better understand the data gathered and how it is applied within a ministry, community, and personal capacity. *(Small group discussions facilitated by travel support group members)*

**Data contextualisation (story telling):** Stories are shared and captured that provide context to the data gathered and discussions had during the data engagement session. *(Story telling captured by video and report writing by travel support group members)*



## DAY 5

Recap and activity day.

An opportunity for the adventure seekers to river raft the Nile river, explore the incredible beauty of the 'source of the Nile' and prepare for the days ahead in Kampala.

### Key Information

Various activities are available and needs to be booked in advance. Details will be provided to those interested to join the team during their time in Uganda.

## DAY 6

Depart early in the morning for Kampala with a stopover at the Mabira Forest, where an opportunity will be given to either go on a forest hike or take a zip line adventure through the forest.

Both the forest hike and zip line are additional cost and needs to be booked in advance. Details will be provided to those interested to join the team during their time in Uganda.

## DAY 7, 8

These two days are exclusively set aside for the workshop discussion sessions with leaders and people from the Kampala region.

The evenings are for group feedback discussion and report writing.

### Key Information

The feedback discussions and report writing are critical elements of the research process, and dedicated time will be allocated to ensure that a comprehensive summary of the experience and discussions had are captured.

## DAY 9

### Departure Day

After breakfast you will depart back to Entebbe for your departure flight.
